**COMMITTEE ACTION**

The Subcommittee on Emergency Communications, Preparedness and Response of the Committee on Homeland Security met, pursuant to notice, in open markup session, a quorum being present, on Wednesday, April 30, 2008, in 311 Cannon House Office Building to consider the following measures: **H.R. 1333**, to amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to direct the Secretary to enter into an agreement with the Secretary of the Air Force to use Civil Air Patrol personnel and resources to support homeland security missions; **H.R. 4183**, to amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish the National Urban Search and Rescue Response System; and **H.R. 5890**, to amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish the Community Preparedness Division of the Department of Homeland Security and the Citizen Corps Program, and for other purposes.

The Committee took the following actions:

**H.R. 1333**, to amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to direct the Secretary to enter into an agreement with the Secretary of the Air Force to use Civil Air Patrol personnel and resources to support homeland security missions; was ordered forwarded to the Full Committee with a favorable recommendation, by voice vote.

H.R. 1333 was AGREED TO, as amended, by a record vote of 8 yeas and 0 nays (Roll Call Vote No. 3).

A motion by Mr. Cuellar to amend the title so as to read: "A Bill to direct the Comptroller General to conduct a study on the use of Civil Air Patrol personnel and resources to support homeland security missions, and for other purposes." was not objected to.

The following amendments were offered:

An Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute offered by Mr. Dent (#1); was AGREED TO by voice vote.

**H.R. 4183**, to amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish the National Urban Search and Rescue Response System. The "National Urban Search and Rescue Response System Act of 2007."; was ordered forwarded to the Full Committee with a favorable recommendation, by voice vote.

H.R. 4183 was AGREED TO, without amendment, by a record vote of 7 yeas and 0 nays (Roll Call Vote No. 1).

**H.R. 5890**, to amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to establish the Community Preparedness Division of the Department of Homeland Security and the Citizen Corps Program, and for other purposes. The “Citizen and Community Preparedness Act of 2008”; was ordered forwarded to the Full Committee with a favorable recommendation, by voice vote.

H.R. 5980 was AGREED TO, as amended, by a record vote of 8 yeas and 0 nays (Roll Call Vote No. 2).

The following amendments were offered:

An Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute offered by Mr. Cuellar (#1); was AGREED TO by voice vote.

A motion by Mr. Cuellar to authorize staff to make any technical and conforming changes to the measures considered today, was not objected to.
